

## FREE Community Snorkel - Seaweed Gardens of Wellington Saturday 17<sup>th</sup> March, 10 am to 3 pm Kau Bay Point (Miramar Peninsula)

We provide expert guides and <u>all gear</u> (wetsuit, fins, mask & snorkel), no experience needed – just bring your togs and towel (minimum age is eight years for snorkelling).

Wellington Underwater Club and Mountains to Sea Wellington have teamed up to give school students and their parents and anyone interested an opportunity to explore their blue backyard. Take a look under the waves of Wellington Harbour and discover the hidden seaweed gardens and forests of the Miramar Peninsula. Learn about the importance of seaweed and the diverse marine life found in Wellington Harbour and what you can do to help Wellington's marine environment thrive.

Experienced snorkel guides will be on hand to guide you in the water and engaging activities on shore will provide you with more information! The minimum age for snorkelling is 8 years, and children below 16 must be accompanied by a snorkelling adult.
